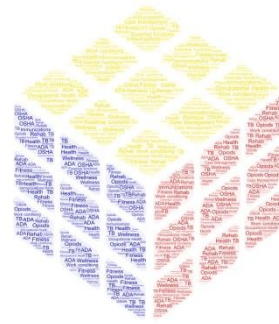

From Greenville on I-85, take exit 69 to business 85. Then take Exit 5-A (I-585 / Pine St.) toward downtown Spartanburg. Go approximately 2 miles to first stoplight. Turn right onto McCravy Drive. Go a short distance to next stoplight. Turn right onto Wood St. Go up the hill. Spartanburg Regional is on the left and the parking garage is on the right. Take the walkway on the 3rd floor to go to the hospital. Stop by the lobby information desk and ask for direction to Heart Center Auditorium
